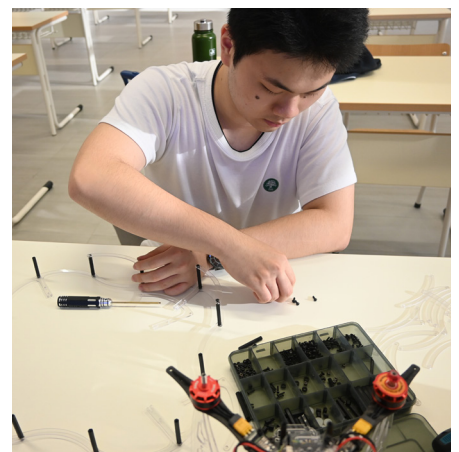


Robotics Club

The club helps our students improve their organizational, time management, and teamwork skills through hands-on learning experiences.



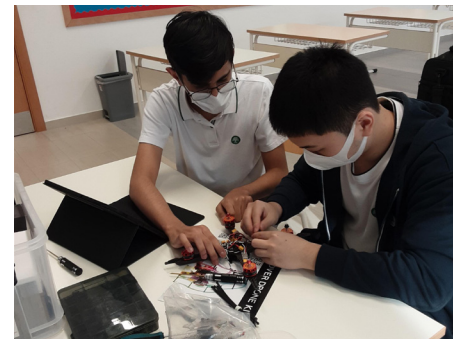
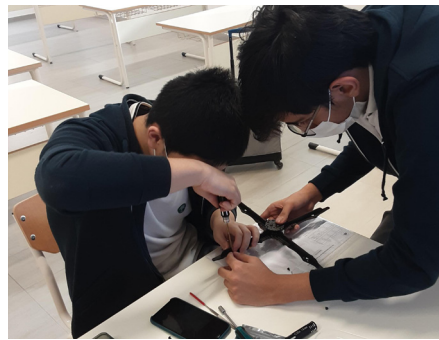
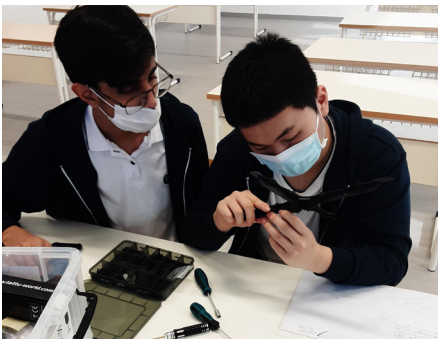


Drone Club

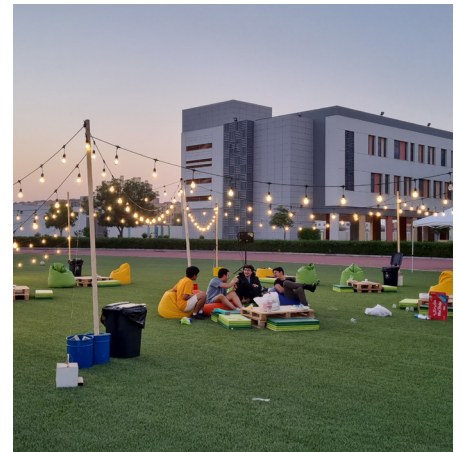
Grades 2 and 3 participated in this campaign by bringing fruits, vegetables, and whole grains to school every day.

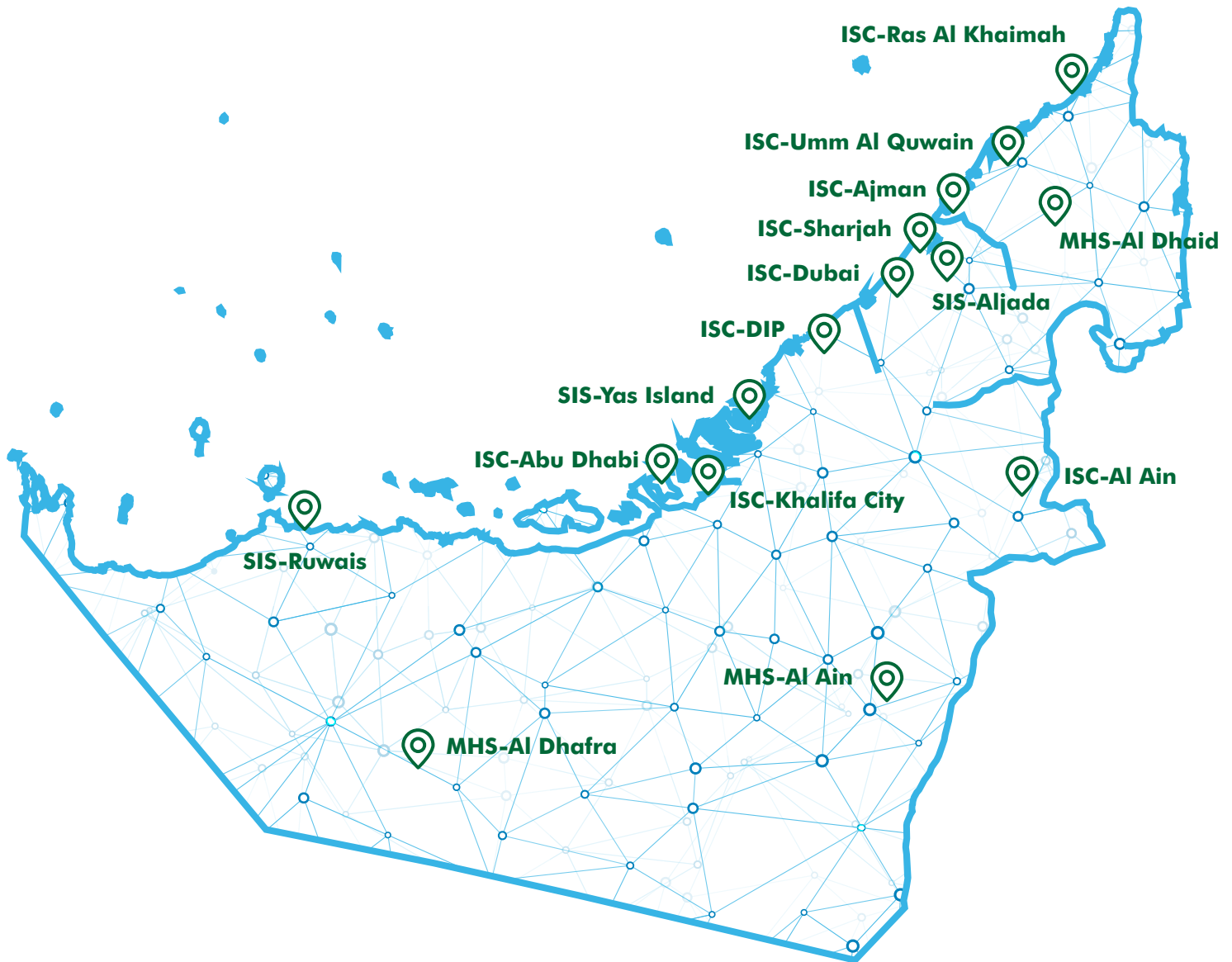
Dubai Aquarium
