All students, parents, teachers, and staff of our school were invited to participate in celebration of this occasion on Thursday, November 25th, 2021.


The event opened with a speech delivered by our school's Acting Director- highlighting the importance and significance of positive principles and the value of patriotism in the hearts of our students.

Big Brother & Big Sister Program


