Looking forward to another fruitful term with our students, parents, and staff.

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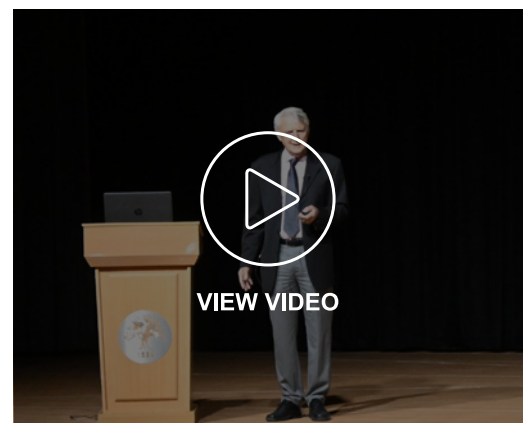
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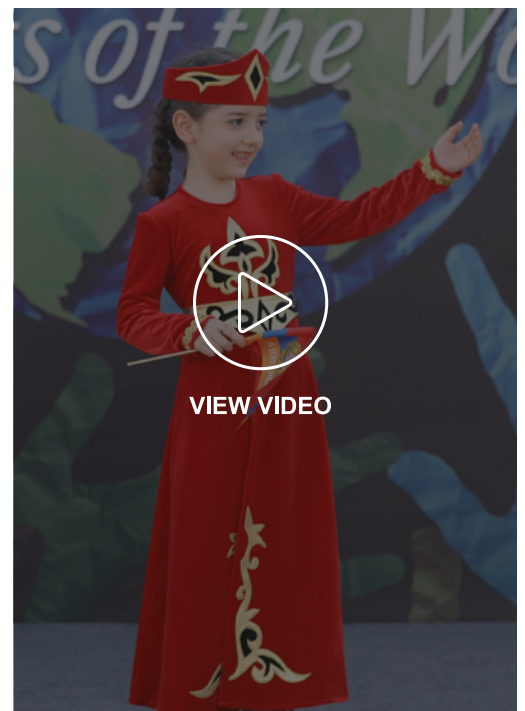
## ISC-Ajman Celebrates First International Day

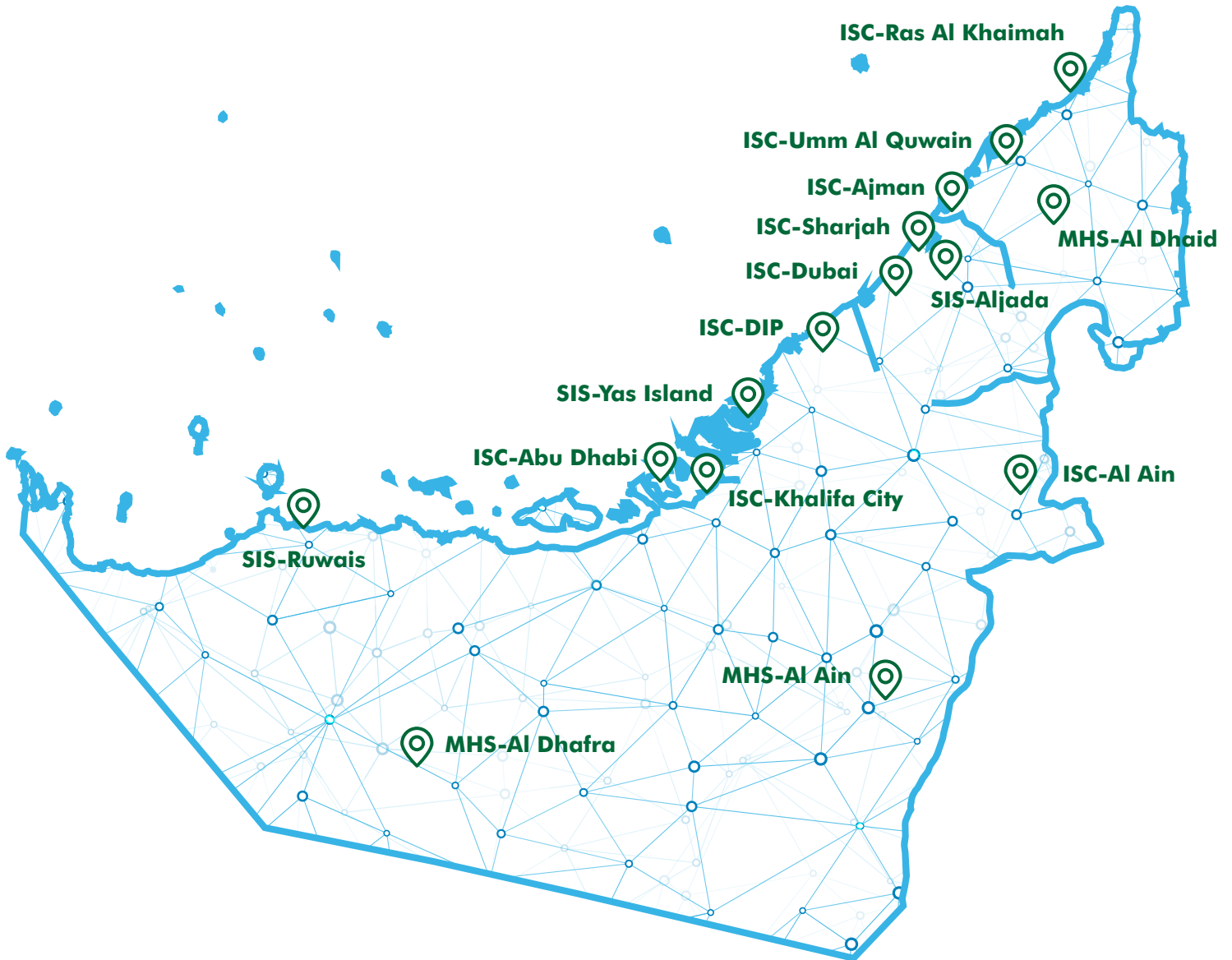

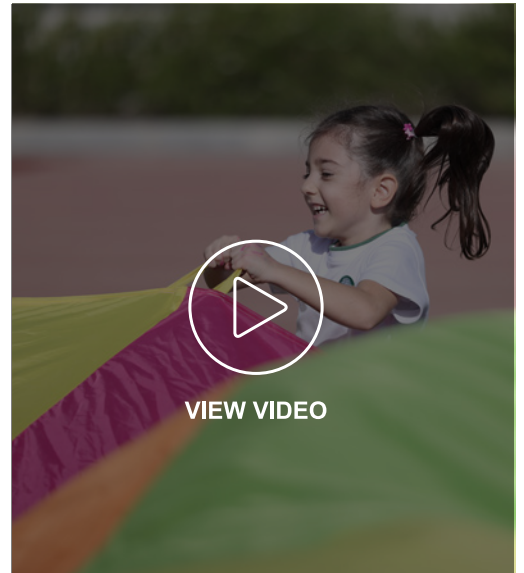

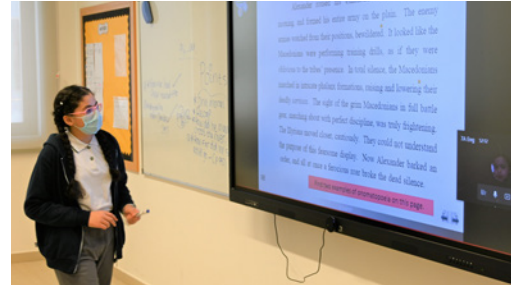
## Shadow Teachers Day

On Friday, February 18, ISC-Ajman witnessed its first Shadow Teacher Day in high spirits.

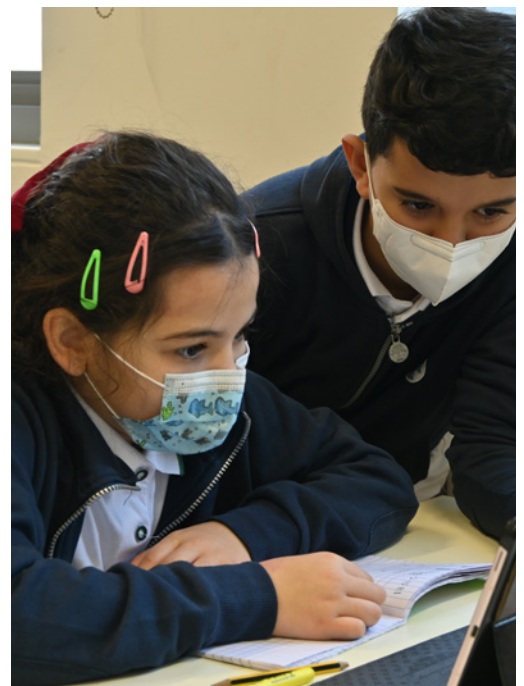
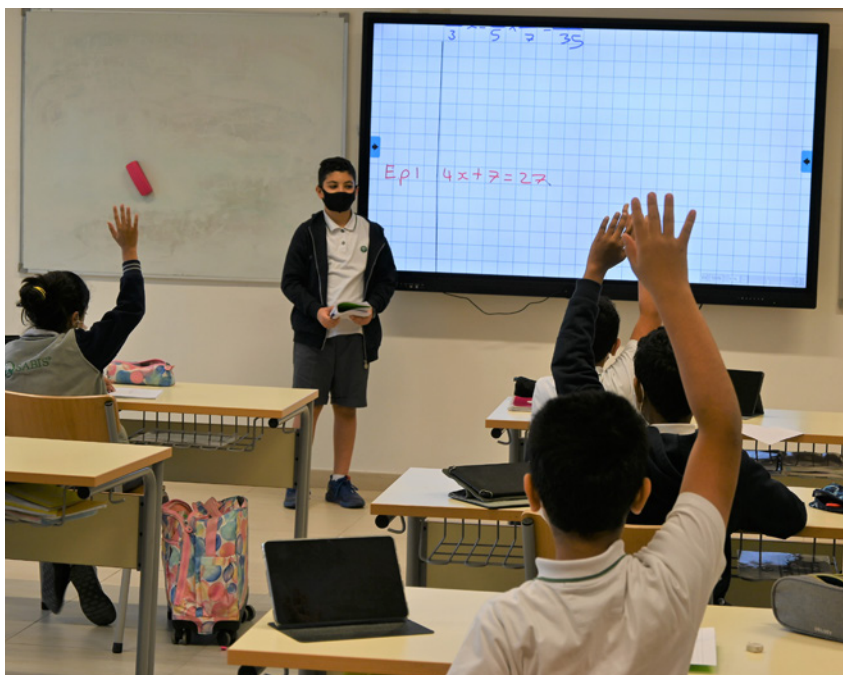
